This "floater" position will allow the agency to respond quickly and effectively to changing needs in the community by providing expert, comprehensive support for rapid relocation projects, sudden or urgent gaps in services, or unique, short-term partnerships. Furthermore, this person will serve as the agency's diversion guru by providing "right time" intervention and support to TFS clients experiencing housing-related challenges.

- Demonstrated experience in multiple housing interventions
